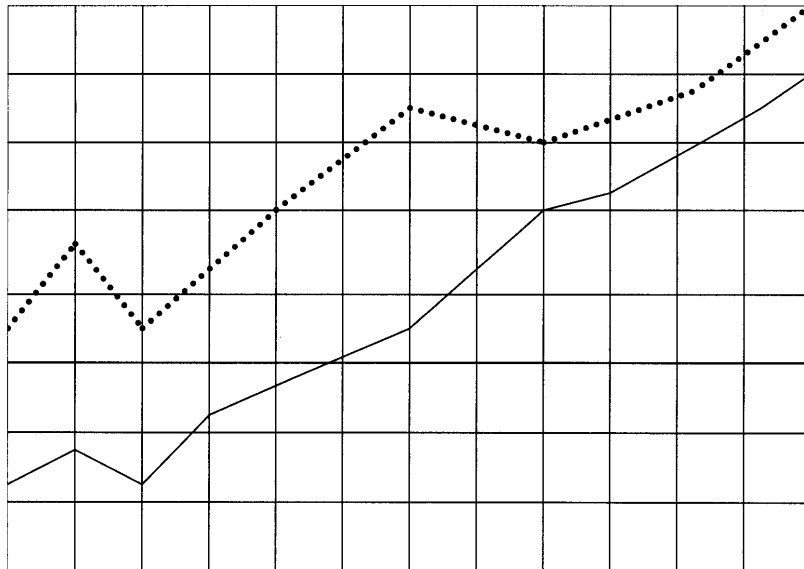

## **PREFACE**

The impact of price movement not only affects the standard of living of the people but also has a significant bearing on project formulation and investment decisions. Government and Private organization or agencies too depend on price statistics for fixation of wages and various other allowances for its future planning.

The present publication on "Price Trends" being twenty sixth in series, besides giving the trends in the movement of retail and wholesale prices for some of the essential commodities in Goa State during the years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003 & 2004 also presents yearly averages prices for the years 1995 onwards. Based on the Index Numbers compiled by this Directorate (for Middle Class Non-Manual Employees with old and Revised Base) and those by the Labour Bureau, Shimla for industrial Workers with old Base (1966=100) for General Index and also with Revised Base (1982=100), an analysis of the price trends has been attempted.

It is hoped that this publication will serve as a useful source for the price information needs of all concerned. While all efforts have been made to incorporate authentic price data in the publication, suggestions for further qualitative improvements in future are most welcome.

The generous co-operation extended by various individuals, shops, agencies, etc. in making available the requisite data is gratefully acknowledged. Shri Rosario E. Botelho - Investigator assisted by Kum. Gail A. Azavedo - Investigator, deserves special mention as they have contributed immensely in terms of collection, compilation, computation and writing of report.

# PRICE TRENDS — GOA STATE

## INTRODUCTION

### 1. GENERAL BACKGROUND

Goa, which was a Union Territory along with Daman and Diu, was conferred Statehood on 30<sup>th</sup> May, 1987. It is administratively divided into two districts viz. North Goa District and South Goa District with their head-quarters at Panaji and Margao, respectively. These districts are further sub-divided into eleven talukas. While North Goa consists of six talukas viz. Tiswadi, Bardez, Pernem, Bicholim, Satari, and Ponda; South Goa comprises of five talukas viz. Sanguem, Canacona, Quepem, Salcete and Mormugao. The geographical area of the State is 3702 Sq. Kms, of which 1736 Sq Kms. is covered by North Goa and the remaining 1966 Sq. Kms. by South Goa. About 1,25,473 hectares of area is under forest and the net area sown is 1,38,015 hectares situated on the west coast of Indian sub continent. The State is endowed with rainfall from the South – West monsoon, the average annual rainfall recorded during the year 2003-04 being 2555 mm.

**1.2** The total population of the state according to the 2001 census, is 13,47,668 of which North Goa had 7,58,573 and South Goa 5,89,095. The density of population of the State is 364 persons per Sq., Kms. The density of population in North Goa is 437 persons per Sq. Kms as against 300 persons per Sq. Kms. in South Goa. The Rural population of the State was 6,77,091 persons of whom North Goa had 4,16,824 and South Goa 2,60,267 . Out of the total workers in the State numbering 4,12,736 persons, 93 percent were main workers and remaining 7 percent, marginal workers.

**1.3** In order to have adequate control over prices and ensure equitable distribution of the essential commodities to the people at reasonable rates, the Government has introduced public distribution of essential commodities through a number of fair price shops. The scale of ration fixed for distribution is shown in Table –I separately for the years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003 & 2004.

### 2. CPI NUMBERS - Its meaning, Scope and use

The Consumer Price Index Numbers indicate the average percentage change in the prices paid by the consumer over a period of time with reference to a base period. The average percentage change, measured by the index is estimated on monthly basis with reference to a fixed period of the index. The index during the base period is taken to be 100 so that the indices for later periods are automatically expressed as percentage with reference to the base period.

The objective of the index is to measure the effect of price change with reference to a fixed basket of goods and services that form part of consumption. This basket reflects a particular level of living of the population group from the point of view of consumption. Thus, the fixed base period of the index provides uniform reference period for consumption purpose and the fixed basket of goods and services enable measurements of the effect of price changes. For example, Consumer Price Index numbers for Middle Class Non- Manual Employees of Goa State for December, 1992 was 292 (Base 1982=100) indicating that the cost of a fixed baskets of goods and services consumed by the middle class non-manual employees in Goa has increased by 192 percent compared to the base year (1982-83) prices.

**2.2** The Index does not measure absolute level of prices, but only indicates the average percentage change in the prices of a fixed basket of goods and services at different points of time.

**2.3** This Index does not also measure changes in the total expenditure of the population group or in other words, their actual cost of living. It measures the effect of price change only.

**2.4** The cost of living population group is influenced by a large number of factors like income, changes in the standard of living, quality of commodities and services consumed, prices etc. It will be readily conceded that one of the most important factors determining change in the cost of living of the population group is the extent to which the prices of goods and services consumed by them change from time to time. The prices and income are correlated. It is so because, if prices go up and income of the population group remains constant, the population group has to spend more for the same quantum of goods and services and this results in a fall in the standard of living. Conversely, if income increases more than prices, then there is an improvement in the living conditions. Thus, a cost of Living Index, in the true sense of the term, has to take into account different factor. Consumer Price Index Numbers, therefore, help us to measure the cost of living.

**2.5** A study of the Consumer Price Index will also enable us to estimate the required change in income which is necessary to maintain a given level of standard of living of the population group covered by the Index.

### **3. CPI NOS. FOR THE MIDDLE CLASS NON-MANUAL EMPLOYEES IN GOA STATE**

The consumer price Index Numbers for the Middle Class Non- Manual Employees in Goa are being compiled by the Directorate of Planning, Statistics and Evaluation since 1966, based on the Family Living Survey conducted in 1965 for Panaji Town. As is well known, the consumption pattern of a given population undergoes radical changes with the passage of time and the series become out-dated. As such, the Central Statistical Organisation, New Delhi carried out a fresh Middle Class Family Living Survey during the year 1982 on a uniform basis throughout the country.

**3.2** A similar survey, on the pattern of the one conducted by the Central Statistical Organisation and approved by the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) on prices and cost of living was carried out by this Directorate during the year 1982 –83, with a view to derive the new Weighting Diagram, based on the latest consumption pattern of the middle class families in Goa. In this survey, four different centers namely Panaji, Margao, Vasco and Mapusa towns were covered. The methodology and sampling design for this series were decided upon in consultation with the Central Statistical organization for the purpose of uniformity.

**3.3** The Consumer Price Index Numbers for the Middle Class Non-Manual Employees are being compiled by this Directorate based on the fresh surveys conducted every weekly and monthly basis. The quarterly Index Numbers are regularly published in the form of a small bulletin. The General and Group wise Index Numbers in Table II, separately for the years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003 and 2004. The average yearly indices on Revised Base 1982-83=100 since 1995 are also given in the same table.

### **4. CPI Nos for Industrial Workers in Goa.**

The series Consumer Price Index Numbers for Industrial workers in Goa was being compiled regularly on old Base (1966=100) by the Labour Bureau, Shimla since 1967. *Since it was felt that with the passage of time the consumption pattern of the*

*working class had gone a change*, the old series was replaced by the New Series with base 1982 =100 on the basis of a working Class Family Income and Expenditure Survey conducted in the year 1981=82, all over the country. The price collection work for the new series in respect of Goa is being done by the officials of the Directorate of Planning, Statistics and Evaluation, Government of Goa.

**4.2** The industrial centers selected for the survey are Margao, Vasco, Ponda, Curcholem, Bicholim and Mapusa. This Index is widely used for regulating the payment of Dearness Allowances to the employees to compensate for the rise in prices. The Dearness Allowance of the employees are either increased or reduced as per the rise and fall of the particular Index with which the Dearness Allowances is linked.

**4.3** The average yearly indices on revised base 1982=100 of the Industrial Workers in Goa have been given in table III separately for the years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003 & 2004 are given in Table III.

## **5. All India CPI Nos. for Urban Non-Manual Employees and Industrial Workers**

Table IV gives month wise All India Consumer Price Index Numbers for both urban Non-Manual Employees and Industrial Workers on base 1960=100. It also gives Annual Index series for the earlier years since 1995. These indices are being compiled by the Central Statistical Organisation (CSO), New – Delhi and the Labour Bureau, Shimla respectively. The Central Statistical Organisation as well as the Labour bureau have since revised the base years to 1984-85=100 and 1982=100 respectively.

**5.2** It is not possible to have a rigorous comparison between the All India series referred to above and the series for Goa, due to the different base years used for compilation of these two different series of Index Numbers viz. series of General Index of Consumer Price Index Numbers for Non-Manual Employees (Base 1984-85=100) for some of the important cities in the country, compiled by CSO, New Delhi and that of Goa State (Base 1982-83=100) compiled by the Directorate of Planning, Statistics and Evaluation, Panaji which are given in Table V and VI respectively. However, for the sake of comparison, estimated figures are given in the above tables by converting the Base Year from 1982-83=100 to 1984-85=100

## **6. Wholesale and Retail Prices**

**Markets in Goa State:** As stated earlier, the State of Goa is administratively divided into 11 talukas. The head quarter of each taluka is considered as local market. However, three towns, viz. Panaji, Margao and Mapusa are the important centres for wholesale and retail trade in the State.

**6.2 Wholesale and Retail Prices:** The annual average wholesale prices of important commodities for the years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003 and 2004 and their monthly spread for Panaji, Margao and Mapusa towns are presented in Tables VII, VIII and IX respectively. Similarly, average retail prices of selected items of common consumption of Non-Manual Employees for Goa State are given in table X. Interested readers may refer to these to have a glimpse of the picture of yearwise and monthwise fluctuations in prices.

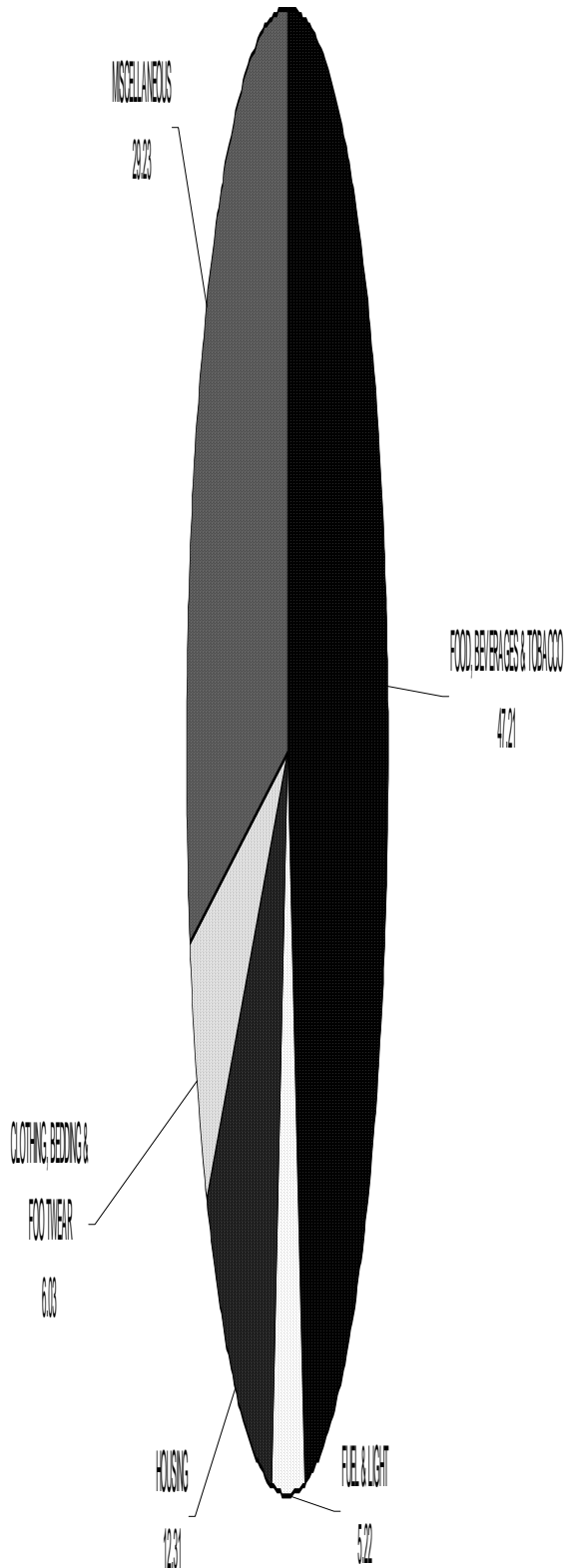




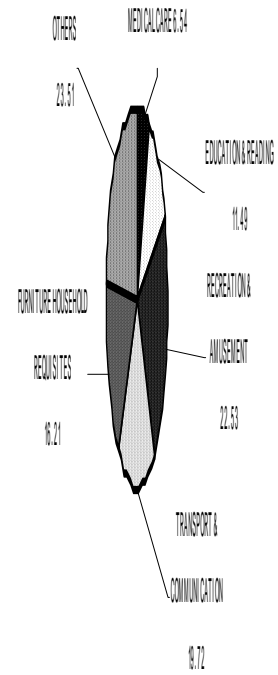
